If they agree, great. If they don't, that's OK too. You've made them aware. You've also made them better. Rules are in place so that no one has an unfair advantage. Uncalled kitchen violations definitely create an advantage.

Go to Voice Memos or Voice Recorder App on your phone and record your predicament and location. Someone trying to get in touch with you will be able to hear the message even if your phone has lost all battery power."
